*The Award Panel makes recommendations to the Clockmakers' Charity. Recommendations will be made on the basis of information provided in this Application Form and, if required, an interview of the applicant by members of the Award Panel.*

*The Award Panel considers applications on a quarterly basis and aims to respond to all applications within four months of submission. All applicants will be notified of the outcome but the Panel is not able to provide details if the application is not approved. Re-applications will not normally be considered.*

*Personal information provided by successful applicants will be retained by the Panel for as long as the terms of the award apply. Personal information provided by unsuccessful applicants will not be retained after the date of the Panel's decision.*

### **Terms of the Award:**

Applicants must be a qualified or experienced professional watchmaker or clockmaker seeking to gain new skills (not readily available on UK courses) or experience or a higher qualification in the UK or abroad in any aspect of watchmaking or clockmaking. Priority will be given to applicants involved in clock or watchmaking rather than repair or restoration.

Those researching or developing the measurement of time or undertaking a higher degree in this area are also eligible to apply.

The Panel reserves the right to impose conditions on the granting of any award. Any such conditions would be communicated at the time of notification.

The maximum annual individual award that will be made is £5,000.
